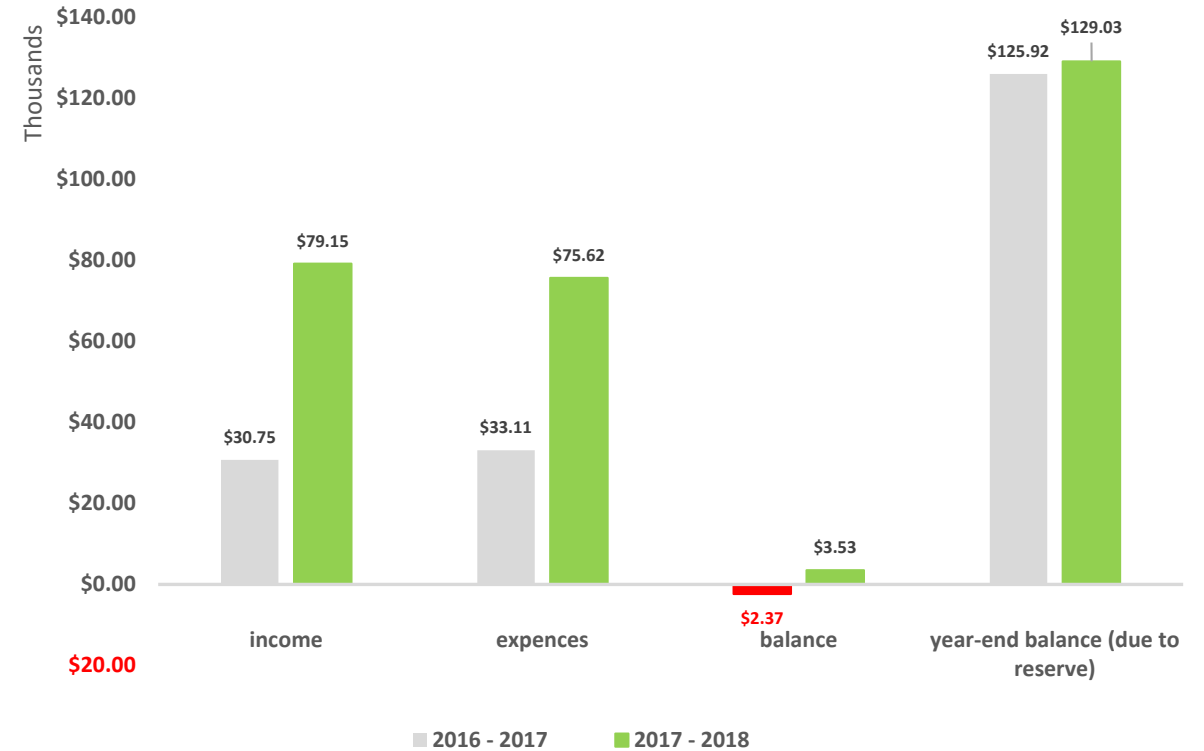

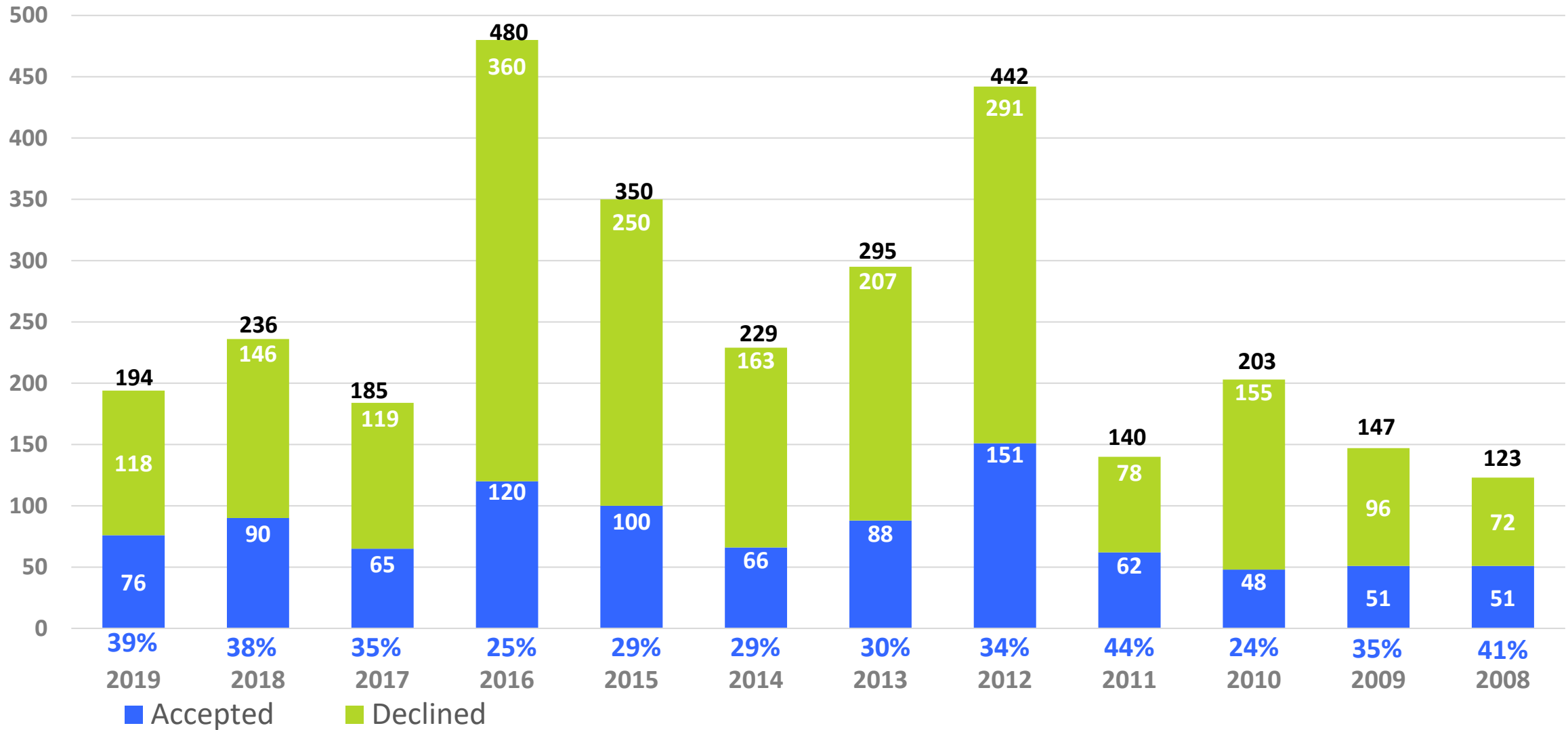

AIA Upjohn Award

The AIA Upjohn Research Initiative supports applied research projects that enhance the value of design and professional practice knowledge.

This AIA program funds up to six research grants of \$15,000–\$30,000 annually for projects completed in a 6-to 18-month period. The funds must be fully matched with hard dollars, with a maximum of 10% allocated for overhead. Grant recipients' research findings and outcomes are published online by AIA.

NO IDENTIFYING INFORMATION – Blind peer review

Deadline August 29, 2019

Grant funding to be allocated to projects related to AIA's priorities for 2019, these include a drive toward design that helps reduce energy use, supports the investment in sustainable buildings, and encourages equitable communities.

Proposed Bylaw Changes

Original:

Section 4.02. Number of Directors.

The number of the Board of Directors shall be nine (9) and shall include the President of the Consortium, the Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, the immediate Past President and four members at large. Members shall be elected by the Council at its annual meeting. The President and Vice President shall be elected for two-year terms to begin on October 1 following the annual Meeting. The Secretary, Treasurer, and all other members shall be elected for one-year terms to begin on October 1 following the annual meeting.

Proposed:

Section 4.02. Number of Directors.

The number of the Board of Directors shall be nine (9) and shall include the President of the Consortium, the Vice President/President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, the immediate Past President and four members at large. Members shall be elected by the Council at its annual meeting. All board members shall be elected for two-year terms to begin on October 1 following the annual Meeting.. In order to establish staggered terms for at large board members, the initial membership term for half those members will be one year only. Elections shall be held annually to fill expired terms.
